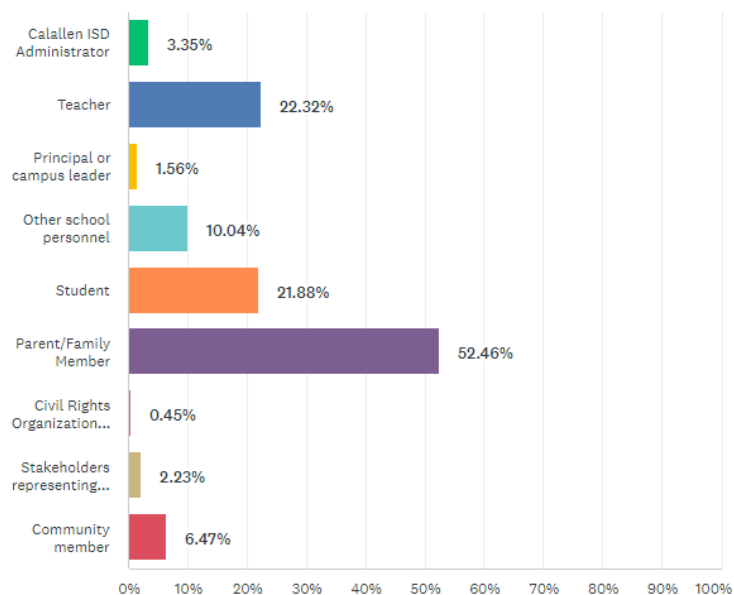
- *District Administrators*

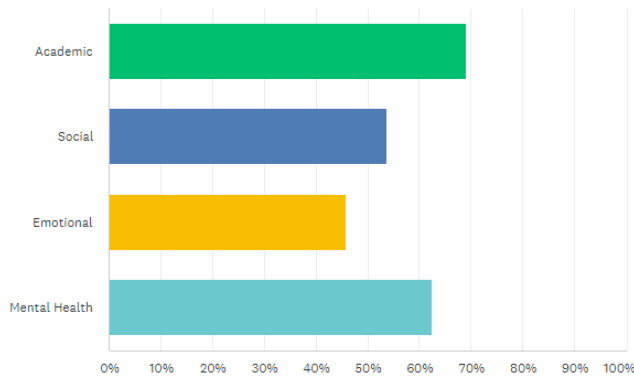
One of the questions asked was “From your perspective, what are the top issues currently facing students and Calallen ISD from the pandemic?”

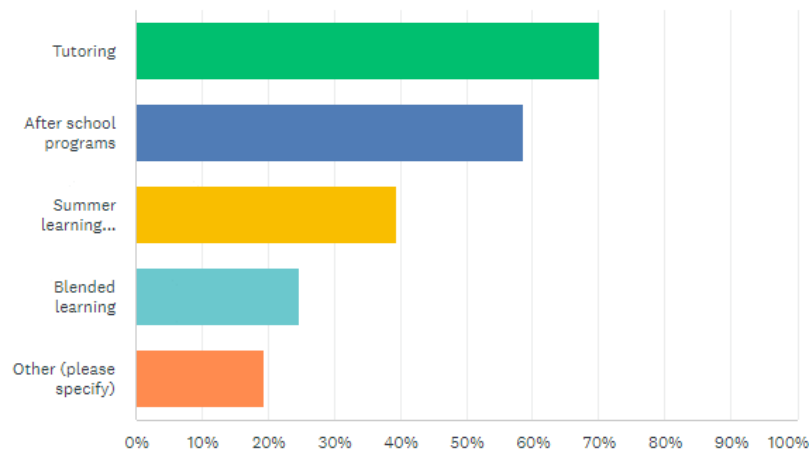
What do you believe are the highest priority needs for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year related to impact of the COVID-19 pandemic?
